## School of Health Professions BIS: Speech-Language Sciences & Technology 2008-2009

This plan prepares the student to enter any post-baccalaureate program in communication sciences and disorders, including NAU's master's degree in clinical speech pathology.

To earn this BIS degree, you must complete at least the following 120 units of coursework, which we describe in the sections that follow:

- At least 35 units of liberal studies requirements. Be aware that you may use courses with a SST prefix to satisfy liberal studies requirements. In addition, you may not use the specific courses in your focus, minor or certificate to also satisfy liberal studies requirements.
- At least 57 units of major requirements, including courses in your emphasis and focus.
- Elective courses, if needed, to reach an overall total of at least 120 units.

Be aware that some courses required for your degree have prerequisites that you must also take. Check the courses in the appropriate subject.

Please note that you must complete NAU's diversity requirements by taking two 3-units courses, one in ethnic diversity and one in global awareness. These courses may be used to meet other requirements within your academic plan if you choose them carefully.

Also be aware that for the B.A. in liberal studies, you must take at least 36 units of upper-division coursework (courses numbered 300 and above). <http://jan.ucc.nau.edu/~hp-p/hs/undergrad/index.php?id=5>
